The youngest members of our school took charge of the WE Scare Hunger campaign. Firefly and Beetle classes organised a school collection of dried goods that was donated to Redbridge Foodbank. This is the second time we have run this campaign and it is one that appears to have a big impact on our children. They show an understanding of how a lack of food can affect us and through discussions with them, they have shown that they understand that hunger is a problem that could affect anyone at anytime. We are very proud of our Reception children for showing a passion in helping others. They have shown that you are never too young to start changing the world!



WE Walk for Water



For the first year ever, the WE charity ran a WE Walk for Water event where schools in the UK, America and Canada took part to help create a positive change in global water issues. We were lucky enough to be one of the schools invited to participate in this event. Our Year 3 children organised and led this event, mapping out a course in the hall that the school had to walk while carrying bottles of water. This allowed us to imagine what it may be like for the thousands of girls who have to do this every day in order to access clean water. As a school we raised £90 which enabled WE to provide clean water for six people for a lifetime!

WE Step Up

Monday 2nd July became a sunny skip-a-thon as the year 5 children arranged a school competition to see who could complete the most skips in 2 minutes. They raised over £100 that will go towards healthcare in one of the WE Villages.

Enterprise Day

We once again held our biggest event of the year, Enterprise Day! Leading up to this event, children researched, and created a product to sell at Aldborough Market. They had to work out costings, organise promotions and make, as well as sell, their products to make the most profit. Our two winning classes were Stingray and Tiger. All classes received back 50% of their profits, with the other half being donated to a WE village to support the development of Education. Each year Enterprise Day gets bigger and bigger, we can't wait till next year!
