It is important that your child attends school everyday and on time. Children can enter school from 8:40am and must be in school by 8:55am.

School Meals

Every child has now been sent a Parent Pay letter. It is important that you are booking for your child's school lunches using this system. This includes Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. If your child is entitled to free school meals and they are in Years 3 to 5 they must also be booked on the system to ensure that we have an accurate number to send to the caterers. The system will show how much the meals will cost but as you go through the checkout will recognise if your child is entitled to Free School Meals and not charge you. If you feel your child is entitled to Free School Meals then please apply on the Redbridge Website or speak with the school office.

All lunches must be booked on Parent Pay the week before.

We are unable to provide lunches for those families who have not paid or booked in advance and we ask you to provide them with a packed lunch instead. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

Uniform

Thank you for the great effort everyone is making with their uniform. Please remember to label all items of clothing so that if your child leaves anything in the playground it can be reunited with them. This includes coats, P.E. kit and even each shoe!
