Attendance

It is important that your child attends school everyday and on time. Children can enter school from 8:40am and must be in school by 8:55am.

The government now class any child with an attendance of 90% or lower as being persistently absent and can lead to a legal proceedings. The London Borough of Redbridge will fine parents for taking children out of school without permission.

Uniform

The children have come back to school looking very smart!

Just a quick reminder that children should be wearing black trousers, skirts or pinafore's as well as the schools purple t-shirt, jumper or cardigan. In addition to this, shoes must be completely black and no trainers or plimsolls. Children who wear earrings should only have studs that they can remove by themselves at P.E. for health and safety. Hair bands could be plain black or purple with no decoration including beads and flowers.

Please send your child in the correct uniform so that we do not have to ask them to change into our spare uniform or remove hairbands.
