End of day arrangements

As part of our commitment to ensuring the safety of our families and to ease congestion in the school, we would like to remind you of the following procedures when collecting your child in September 2019:

- Only one adult to enter the building when collecting children from class
- When moving around the building please stay on the right hand side
- If you have younger children who do not attend the school, please either leave them in their buggies with the member of staff located in the main playground or carry them to ensure their safety
- Once you have collected your child/children from their classroom, please leave the premises including the playground as soon as possible
- Any child who is not collected by 3:25pm must be collected from the late room located in Beetle class. The exit located on St. Johns Road will be shut at 3:25pm therefore please use the gates next to the main office on Aldborough Road South. There will be a fine for parents who are consistently late collecting their children.

Please see below for the entrances and exits to use throughout the year:

Beetle and Firefly (Red entrance) – Gates located on Aldborough Road South by the main office
Squirrel, Chipmunk and Lemur (Blue entrance) – Doors located in the Reception playground by the ramp

Otter, Stingray and Barracuda (Green entrance) – Doors located in the main play ground

Chameleon, Iguana and Leopard (Orange entrance) – Entrance located on Aldborough Road South

Tiger, Shark and Eagle (Purple entrance) – Doors located by the stairs near Reception classrooms

Lunch trollies for Years 4, 5 and 6 will be located near the entrances listed above. All other trollies will be outside of classrooms.
